Reading fluency refers to a learner's ability to read smoothly and with expression. Good oral reading fluency can be defined as how well a student decodes words without delay using appropriate voice inflection and articulation.

Appropriate grade level development 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade Child performs at the appropriate level for:

• Oral Reading Fluency – Child can read grade level material with expression, appropriate speed, and accuracy. Rate at middle of 3<sup>rd</sup> grade is 88-115 words per minute with those at or above 115 having hit the expected target.
